The revenue source of this fund is:

- State collected 2% tax on rental of transient accommodations

The uses for this fund are:

- Tourism – 30% state required distribution to the Greenwood Visitors/Tourism
- Tourism – Distribution recommended by Tourism Committee
- County – \$25,000 +% authorized distribution to County

Subject: Tourism Related Funds Available for Non-profit Organizations

Each year accommodations taxes collected from Greenwood County's hotels and motels are returned to the County for the purpose of promoting tourism, cultural events, and other related projects. The Greenwood County Accommodations Tax commission has responsibility for soliciting requests from non-profit organizations, and making recommendations to County Council as to how the funds available should be prioritized.

This year's program is now underway, and the Accommodations Tax Commissioners are encouraging and inviting any qualifying organizations to review the application process to see if their particular projects might qualify for consideration. Requests **must** meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Arts and Cultural Events
- Civic or Cultural Events
- Tourism Related Transportation Services

Required application forms are available at the Greenwood County Treasurer's Office.

Although applications may be submitted at any time, those desiring consideration for funding in 2012-2013 **must** submit a completed form no later than **Friday, September 21, 2012**.

Definitions and Project Categories

By statute, non-profit organizations may request accommodations tax funding for tourism related expenditures. An expenditure must meet the following two tests:

- a. The expenditure must be used to attract or provide for tourists
- b. The expenditure cannot be used for an item that would normally be provided by the county or municipality

A "tourist" is defined as a person who is taking trips outside his or her home community for any purpose other than daily commuting to and from work.

Project Categories (appropriate category to be filled in on reverse side of this form)

1. **Advertising and Promotion of Tourism**
Expenditures that would qualify under this category include monies spent on magazine, newspaper, brochure, radio or television advertising in an attempt to promote the municipality or county to tourists.
2. **Arts and Cultural Events**
This category includes money used for advertising or promotion of a particular festival or, money used for advertising and promoting arts and cultural events held in the county or municipality in an effort to attract tourists. Examples of events qualifying under this category include symphony orchestras, art shows, theater productions, home and garden or touring shows.
3. **Facilities for Civic and Cultural Events**
Monies can be used for the construction, maintenance, and operation of facilities for cultural and civic activities. Eligible expenditures can include the costs incurred in building a civic center, museum or coliseum. Tourism-related monies can also be used to fund the continued operation of these facilities including management fees, salaries, and repairs or additions to a facility. Please note that the facility must enhance the ability to attract tourists and not provide a purely local function or benefit.
4. **Tourist Transportation**
Qualifying expenditures in this category would include tourist shuttle buses or trolleys to transport persons from airports to hotels or from hotels to tourist attractions or from attractions to other attractions.
5. **Visitors Centers**
Expenditures may be used for operation and maintenance of visitors' centers whose primary purpose is to provide information, brochures, and other services to tourists.

Notes:

SC Revenue Ruling #98-22 will serve as the basis for determining qualifying requests

Greenwood is not a high concentration tourism area and is therefore disqualified for using these funds for added municipal services (fire or police), utilities, or public facilities to serve tourists.

Greenwood County Council has appointed an Accommodations Tax Commission to solicit and review written request from non-profit organizations for funding of tourism related activities inside Greenwood County.

You may apply for funding using the enclosed form, if your organization has a project or program that qualifies as one of the following:

- Arts and Cultural Events
- Facilities for Civic or Cultural Events
- Tourism Transportation

Please check the reverse side of the form to determine if your proposal meets criteria. Also, we ask that you visit www.atax.sc.gov and review the guidelines to follow for tourism (section V).

Please remember, if you have requested or received accommodations funds from any other municipalities or counties it must be reported. Also, if your organization received accommodation tax funding last year, **you must attach a financial statement of how these funds were actually spent and complete the enclosed Accommodations Tax Detailed Form in addition to the summary form. Your information should include the following:**

- The total attendance to the event/project vs. the number of total tourists in attendance.
- The economic impact generated by tourism to the event/project.
- An overall description of how the event/project attracts and promotes tourists to the area and specifically how the A-Tax funds were used to accomplish this
- How does this event/project promote, attract and provide for tourists?

Please submit 16 copies to the Treasurer's Office (Park Plaza 106) by **September 21, 2012, 5:00 p.m.**, in order to be considered for the next funding cycle. Feel free to contact me at 942-8505 if you need assistance.
