

Yard Waste Pick up policy For Greenwood County

This service is limited to single family residential yard waste that is generated by the normal maintenance of the yard. As performed by the occupant.

Yard waste is defined as vegetative material such as clipping, pruning, leaves, and small tree parts.

Lot clearing debris, professional tree removal, and waste generated by commercial landscapers will not be picked up by the county and is the responsibility of the property owner. Items such as discarded furniture, appliances, old lumber, wire, landscape timbers, garden hoses, plastic containers are not accepted for curbside pick up.

Pick up will be limited to one pile per residence per month, and this pile will approximate seven cubic yards in volume (ten foot long, six foot wide, and three foot high) No more than twenty bags of yard waste will be picked up per month.

Leaves, needles, and small clippings must be bagged to prevent blowing off the truck

A limit of two small trees with parts cut no larger than four feet in length and six inches in diameter will be accepted for pick up.

Yard waste to be picked up should be placed along the edge of the road or street adjoining the homeowner's property. Care should be taken so as to prohibit the yard waste from becoming a traffic hazard.

As there are no regular routes **it is important to call (864) 942-8662 to have the yard waste picked up.** The response time is about two weeks after your call is received.
