The Greenwood County Coroner's Office self submitted to this process for the purpose of ensuring the operating policies, procedures and practices are within international guidelines.

The Greenwood County Coroner's Office was subjected to review of 288 standards including administrative, forensic, investigative and facility review.

The IAC&ME requires 100% compliance of mandatory standards and 90% of all applicable standards.
