

ANNEX 25 SPECIFIC IMPACT HAZARDS TO GREENWOOD COUNTY'S EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN

I. INTRODUCTION

- A. Hazard rankings identify a variety of potential threats that could impact the Greenwood County. Direction, control, and response procedures applicable to this annex are addressed in the basic plan.
- B. Most hazards are addressed in single hazard plans and are Appendices to this Annex. In such cases, this annex will refer to those plans. When the hazard is not addressed in a single appendix to this annex the provisions of the basic plan will be used for a framework of response.
- C. Review this annex and develop Standard Operation Procedures (SOPs) for each task established by appendixes and/or the EOP. Each procedure will insure that the special needs community is factor into their response.
- D. Annually review the State EOP & Department of Homeland Security Universal Task List and integrate tasks as appropriate.

II. MISSION

To provide a coordinated application of county resources for the threats highlighted in this annex.

III. CONCEPT OF OPERATIONS

- A. The policy of Greenwood County is to be prepared for any emergency or disaster in accordance with South Carolina State Regulations 58-1 and 58-101 which require contingency plans and implementing procedures for major hazards.
- B. Coordination with all appropriate departments/agencies and organizations will be performed to ensure operational readiness in time of emergency.
- C. Hazard-specific plans and supporting implementing procedures (SOPs) will be developed and maintained by the Greenwood County departments and or agencies as outlined in the responsibilities section below.
- D. Under the general coordination of the Emergency Management Director, all County departments and or agencies will provide support.
